

Found the 1 1/4" iron bar set by Blakeslee and verified by his ties.

This monument is 4.6' East of the straight line and at the split between section corners.

I accepted Blakeslee's corner as the best available evidence of the original government corner and replaced it with a Lunde Monument.

Describe or show any material discrepancy between the location of the restored corner and that of the corner previously restored or re—established.


John E Davidson established this corner in December 1852.

Wm Knower was at this corner, in June 1886, during a survey in Section 19. He shows finding the government corner.

Richard Blakeslee was at this corner, in April 1996, during a survey in Section 19. He shows he set an 1/4" iron bar at a 2-way fence corner and prepared a tie sheet.


